

Frequently Asked Questions - GLASS PAINTING 101

QUESTION

What equipment and tools do I need to complete this course?

ANSWER

- This is the list of the equipment that you will need to complete the course. You need access to a GLASS KILN to fire your paints and stains.
 - 1. Several rectangular pieces of clear float glass of various sizes. When teaching I usually work on glass pieces around 140mm x 200mm in size, as this is a good size to fit in my kiln.
 - 2. Small quantity of traditional vitreous glass paint. I suggest buying the following 28g size Reusche Glass paints and stain. Bistre Brown Paint DE402, Tracing Black DE 401 and Yellow Silver Stain #3 1384 LINK https://peliglass.eu/product-category/painting/
 - 3. Gum Arabic in liquid or powder form (smallest size available)
 - 4. Rigger Brushes and a set of smaller Tracing Brushes
 - 5. Badger Brush and wide flat Hake brush
 - 6. English Stippler brush and smaller scrub brushes
 - 7. Glass palette and palette knife
 - 8. Water sprayer bottle
 - 9. Wooden Barbeque sticks, or porcupine quills
 - 10. Good quality P3 mask to protect from particulates and dusk and disposable gloves
 - 11. White vinegar 5% acetic acid
 - 12. Optional extra Dipping pens, clove oil, lavender oil and small jars
